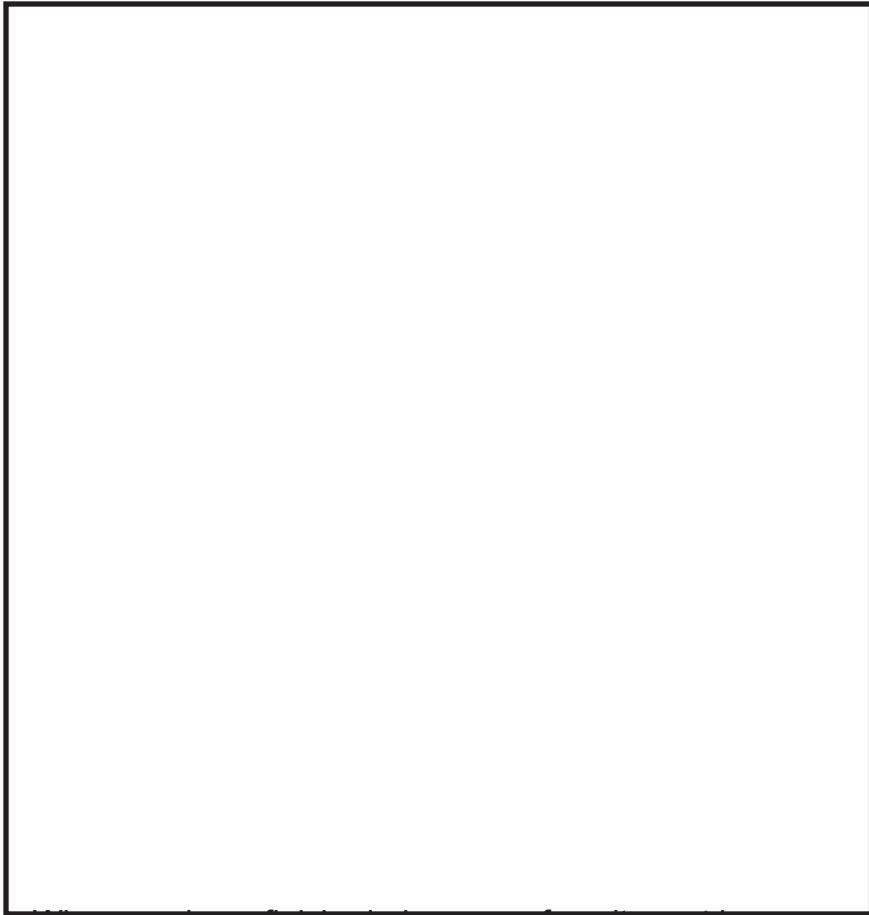

Hint: He had something to do with a giant and his name was

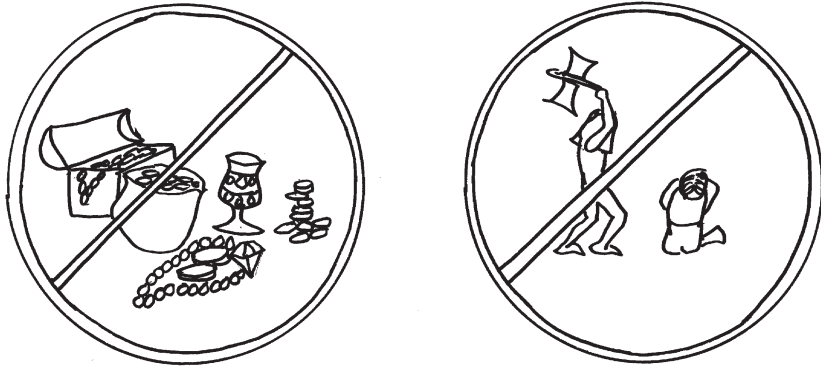

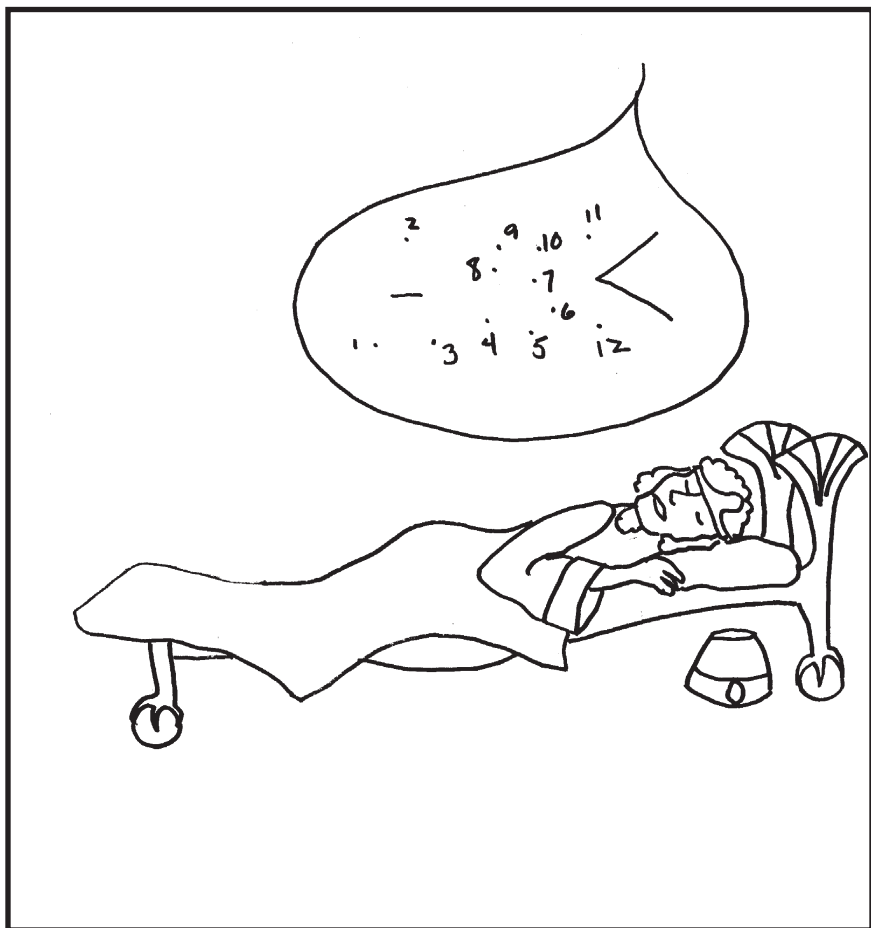
Bonus: Write the name of the giant in code.

One night when Solomon was sleeping he had a dream. In the dream, God told him that he could ask for anything that he wanted!

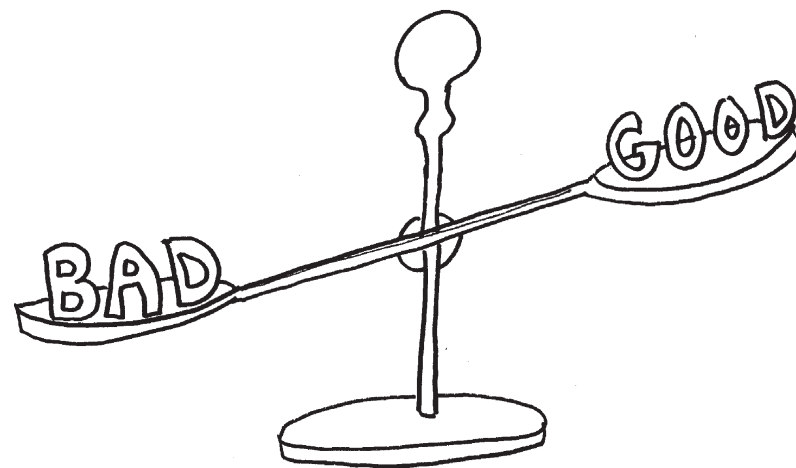
