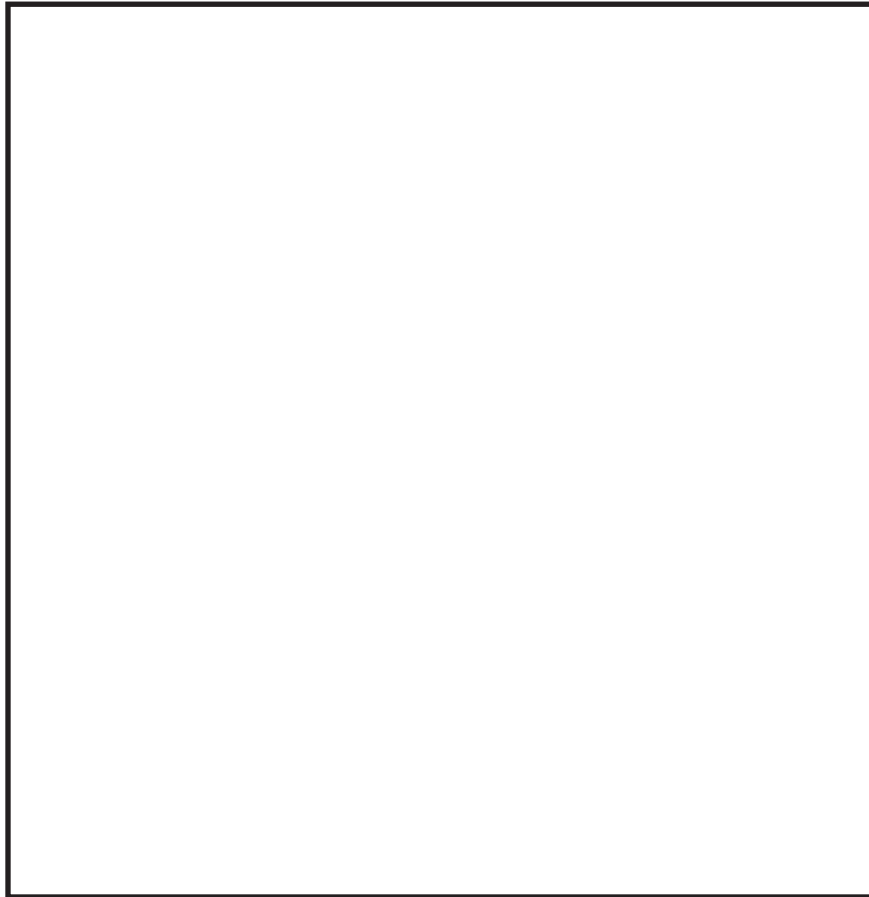


# Jesus Washes Their Feet

(Matthew 12, John 13)

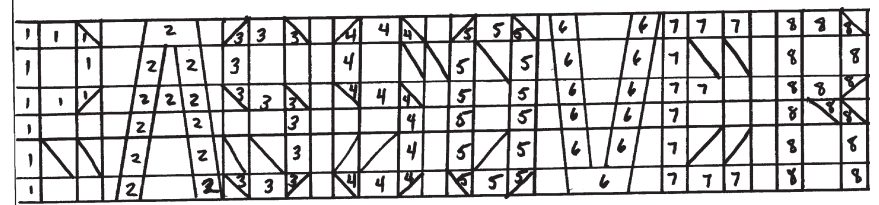
