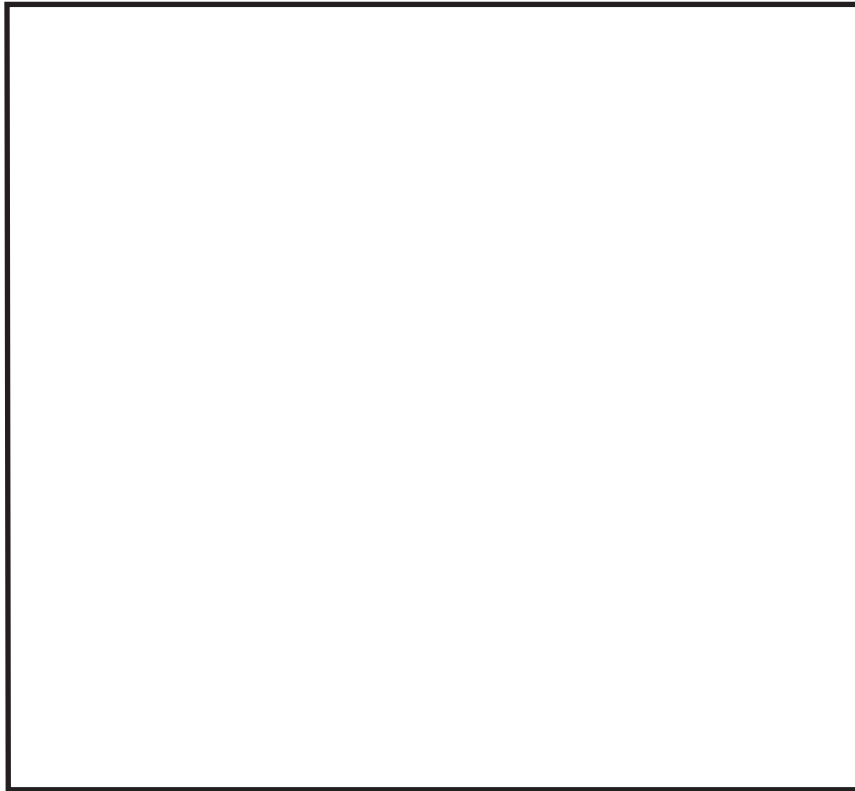

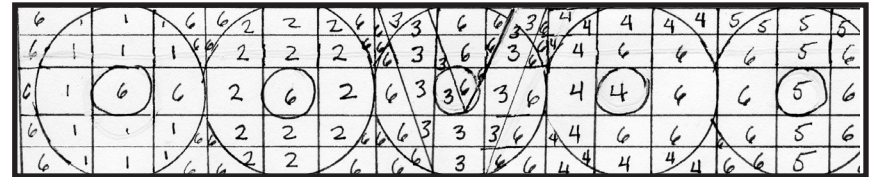

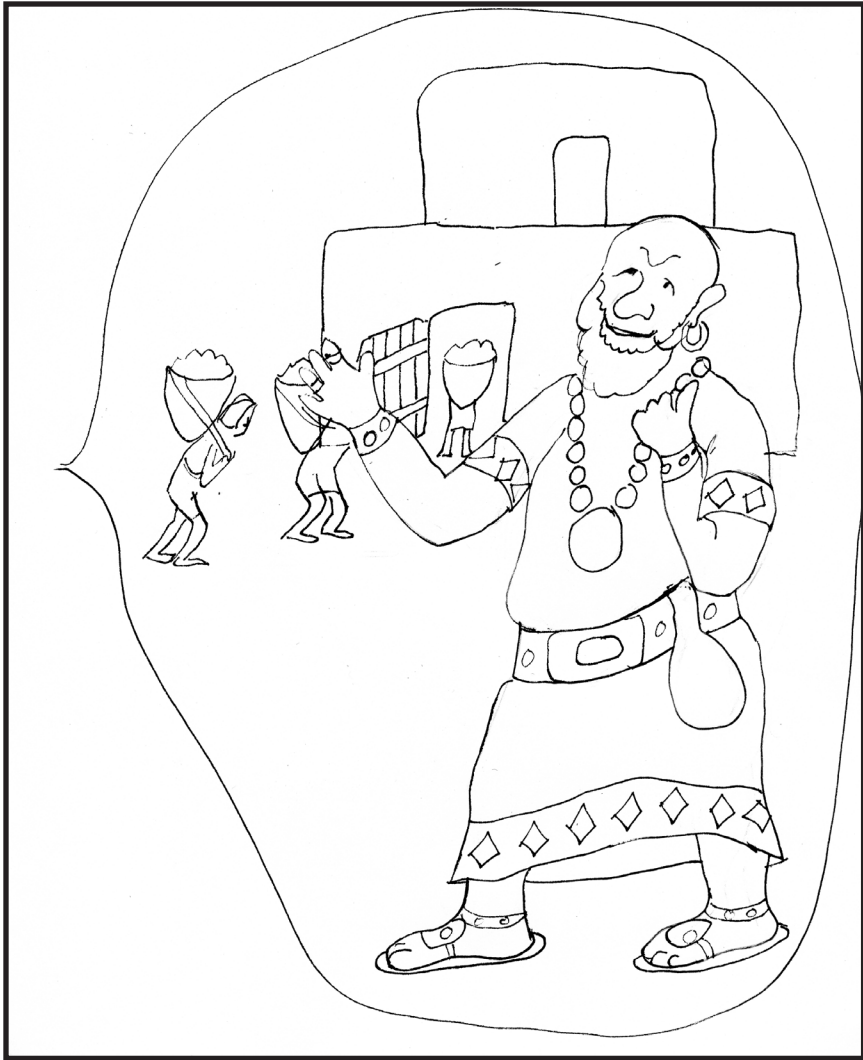
Thou shalt not
