



Paul liked to go places and tell people the good news about Jesus. One time he went to Athens. It was a very fancy city but they worshipped so many different gods!








When he was walking around Athens he had seen this.



After they beat Paul and Silas they put them in the strongest part of the prison.




What do you think that Paul and Silas did then? They sang songs of thanks to God and they prayed.

and all things;”


