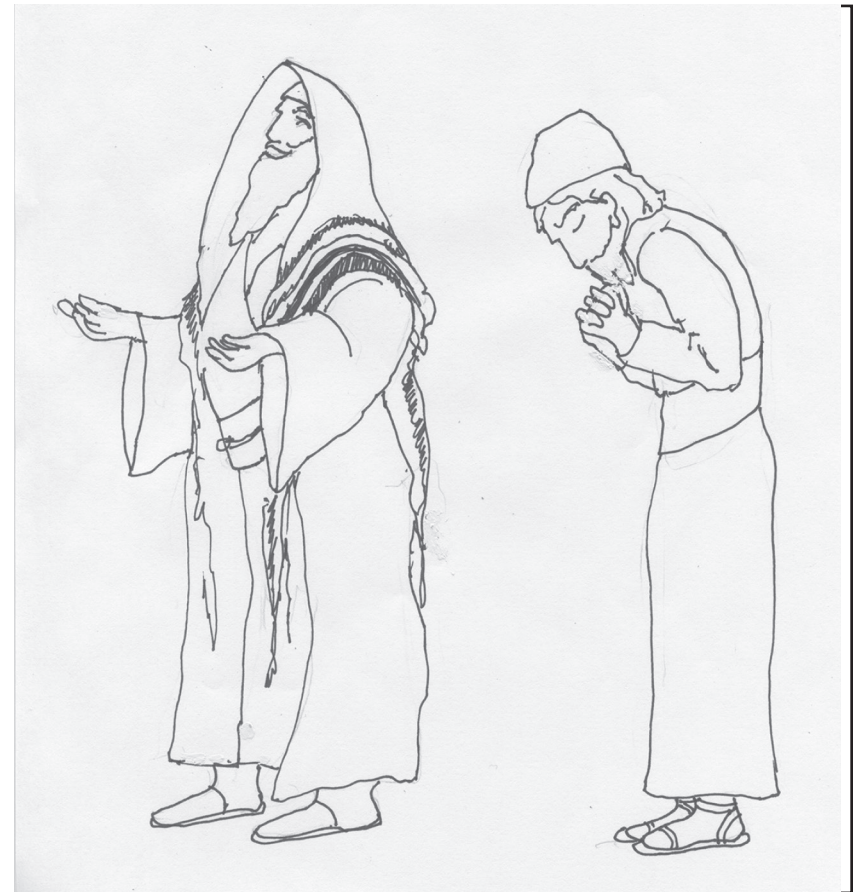


The Parable of the Pharisee and the Publican (Luke 18)
